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**Cameron Village** a national historical register district started in 1875, is spread throughout three blocks of antique shops, old homes and beautiful churches. Your guests will enjoy walking down the main street of a revitalized 19<sup>th</sup> century railroad town where antiques spill onto the porches of Victorian era mercantile stores and homes. With diverse antique dealers represented, your guests will discover treasures for every antique lover. To satisfy your hunger from shopping you may choose to have lunch the Dewberry Deli (Old Hardware).

If you plan to be in the area the first Saturday of May or October, be sure to visit the Cameron Antiques Fair. More than 300 dealers display their antiques and collectibles in the village shops and along streets at this popular bi-annual event.

**Tour Details:** This four hour tour will depart from the Carolina Hotel. An expert guide will conduct a walking tour of the village, which includes shopping and lunch at Miss Belle's Tea Room. This quaint restaurant offers a variety of light soups, gourmet sandwiches and salads. During lunch Miss Belle's daughter, Isabelle will be the guest speaker discussing the rich history of Cameron.
